



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The ISE Pathway program typically spans eight months and is designed to prepare students for academic studies in a wide range of undergraduate degree programs. The pathway program equips students with the necessary English proficiency to gain admission to degree programs offered by universities in Ireland or other English-speaking countries. The program consists of 15 hours per week of General English, 5 hours per week of IELTS Preparation, and 6 hours per week of specific modules.

ISE Pathway allows participants to enhance their academic English skills and prepare for the **IELTS** test, enabling them to achieve an **IELTS** score required for entry to an **Irish University**.
